## <u>British Community Foundation Council Meeting – Key Decisions</u>

## 6 May 2025

The Council took note of the BCF Constitution and Enforcer's terms and conditions, agreed the Council Terms of Reference and noted the appointment of Ambassador Neerav Patel as Chair, Deputy Ambassador Duncan Hill as Vice Chair and David Lish as Treasurer.

The Council agreed the BCF should offer a broad range of projects and events and should engage the British community directly to solicit input and suggestions. To support BCF launch, the Council asked the Enforcer to prepare a detailed action plan.

The Council asked the Enforcer and Treasurer to prepare an Investment Policy Statement to support responsible investment of BCF assets, ensuring the Foundation remains sustainable in the long term.
