2nd June 2026

Layla Husmann reviewed core event progress, noting smooth playgroup operations, successful SEN coffee mornings and a newly launched playgroup at King's College. Challenges with teen events due to heat and padel coordinating were discussed, alongside the organization of new events such as the Quiz night and Mixer events.

The Council approved two new upcoming initiatives: a zero-funding intellectual Children's Quiz at DESS and a morning book club named BCF Book Club "Liberty Reads" at the Liberty Cafe. Dates are finalized for the Winter Bazaar, which has been officially moved forward to November 20th and 21st to avoid conflicts with the Embassy's King's Birthday Party.

All six voting Council members confirmed their intention to continue their terms. Finally, the Council agreed to the next regular meeting on September 6th.
