6th September 2026

Layla Husmann reviewed recent community events and the programme for the new term. The Council noted positive attendance and feedback from the summer Quiz Night, teen activity and social mixer, and discussed the return of regular playgroups, the next social mixer and the Ask Me Anything community event.

The Council formally approved a temporary increase in the Enforcer's working commitment during the busy autumn period to support the increased workload associated with the Winter Bazaar and the Foundation's wider programme of events and administration.

Planning for the Winter Bazaar on Friday 20th and Saturday 21st November was reviewed. The Council discussed event infrastructure, vendors, food and beverage, volunteers, children's activities and ways to encourage voluntary community contributions.
